We're always seeking to share projects and ideas in order to create better skate spaces.

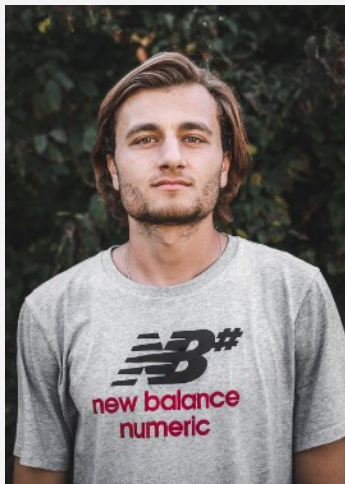
